In the multitude of Thy strength Thy enemies shall lie to Thee. *V.* Glory be to the Father.

**COLLECT** O God, who dost show to them that are in error the light of Thy truth, that they may return into the way of righteousness; grant to all those who profess themselves Christians to reject those things which are contrary to that name, and follow such things as are agreeable to the same. Through our Lord.

**EPISTLE: 1 Peter 2: 11-19** Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, to refrain yourselves from carnal desires, which war against the soul, having your conversation good among the Gentiles: that whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by the good works which they shall behold in you, glorify God in the day of visitation. Be ye subject therefore to every human creature for God's sake: whether it be to the king as excelling, or to governors as sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and for the praise of the good: for so is the will of God, that by doing well you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: as free, and not as making liberty a cloak for malice, but as the servants of God. Honour all men: love the brotherhood: fear God: honour the king. Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the forward. For this is thankworthy before God: in Christ Jesus our Lord.

And He said to them: Of this do you inquire among yourselves, because I said: A little while, and you shall not see Me; and again a little while, and you shall see Me? Amen, amen, I say to you, that you shall lament and weep, but the world shall rejoice: and you shall be made sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy. A woman, when she is in labour, hath sorrow, because her hour is come; but when she hath brought forth the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world. So also you now indeed have sorrow: but I will see you again and your heart shall rejoice: and your joy no man shall take from you.


## NEW WEEKLY BIBLE STUDY: "THE GOSPEL OF LUKE"





## Blessed Margaret of Castello Prayer Group:

Two of our parishioners, Mrs. Terina Davulis and her daughter Julianna are trying to organize a monthly prayer group for handicapped individuals here at Mary Immaculate of Lourdes on the 2nd Wednesdays of each month, beginning with the 12:30 p.m. Mass and continuing with a meeting in the lower rectory conference room. This past Wednesday, the 12:30 PM Mass was offered in Honor of Blessed Margaret Castello [feast-day April 13th], patroness saint of the group. Blessed Margaret of Castello (1287-1320 A.D.), is patroness of the unwanted and the handicapped. A severely handicapped person herself, she was abandoned by her parents as a child. She was cared for by various families of the city and later became a third-order Dominican. In 1558, 238 years after her death, it was discovered that her body was miraculously incorrupt. This new group is working in collaboration with our Lay Dominicans.


**ST. MARK'S DAY
