

Pastor's Note



HOLY CROSS DAY: TITULAR FEAST OF OUR ARCHDIOCESAN CATHEDRAL

On Wednesday of this week, September 14th, we celebrate the annual feast of the Exaltation of

the Holy Cross or "Holy Cross Day". Contained within the liturgical feast is the commemoration of two historical events: the Finding of the Holy Cross by St. Helena and the dedication of the basilicas consecrated at Jerusalem on September 14th, A.D. 335, on the very site of the Holy Sepulchre and the Mount of Calvary, and the recovery of the Holy Cross in A.D. 629 by the Byzantine Roman Emperor Heraclius from the Persians, who had carried it off as war booty from their sack of Jerusalem fifteen years earlier.

At a deeper level, the Exaltation of the Holy Cross contains all of the Mystery of our Redemption in the atoning Sacrifice of Christ on Good Friday. A spirit of thanksgiving and of faith-assurance are most appropriate to this Feast.

Holy Cross Day is also the titular feast of our Archdiocesan Cathedral located in the South End of Boston. Our Cathedral of the Holy Cross is in possession of a relic of the True Cross, a great blessing indeed.



LATIN MASS PROPERS: FOURTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

INTROIT: Psalm 83. 10, 11 BEHOLD, O God, our protector, and look on the face of Thy Christ: for better is one day in Thy courts above thousands. *Ps. ibid.* 2. How lovely are Thy tabernacles, O Lord of hosts! my soul longeth and fainteth for the courts of the Lord. $\tilde{\mathbb{V}}$. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — Behold, O God ...

COLLECT FAVOR Thy Church unceasingly, O Lord, we beseech Thee, and keep her safe: and because apart from Thee frail man is wont to fall, may she by Thy help be ever withdrawn from harm and guided in good. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.

EPISTLE: From the Letter of Blessed Paul the Apostle to the Galatians, 5. 16-24. BRETHREN: Walk in the spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lusts of the flesh: for the flesh lusteth against the spirit, and the spirit against the flesh; for these are contrary one to another; so that you do not the things that you would. But if you are led by the spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are manifest; which are fornication, uncleanness, immodesty, luxury, idolatry, witchcrafts, enmities, contentions, emulations, wraths, quarrels, dissensions, sects, envies, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like; of the which I foretell you, as I have foretold to you, that they who do such things shall not obtain the Kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is, charity, joy, peace, patience, benignity, goodness, longanimity, mildness, faith, modesty, continency, chastity. Against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified their flesh with the vices and concupiscences.

GRADUAL: Psalm 117. 8-9. IT is good to confide in the Lord, rather than to have confidence in man. It is good to trust in the Lord, rather than to trust in princes. ALLELUIA: Psalm 94. 1. Alleluia, alleluia. Come, let Come, let us praise the Lord with joy; let us joyfully sing to God our Savior. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: Continuation of the holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, 6. 24-33. **AT THAT TIME**, Jesus said to His disciples: No man can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will sustain the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I say to you, be not solicitous for your life, what you shall eat, nor for your body, what you shall put on. Is not the life more than the meat, and the body more than the raiment? Behold the birds of the air; for they neither sow nor do they reap, nor gather into barns, and your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are you not of much more value than they? And which of you, by taking thought, can add to his stature one cubit? And for raiment why are you solicitous? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they labor not, neither do they spin; but I say to you, that not even Solomon in all his glory was arrayed as one of these. Now if God so clothe the grass of the field, which is today, and tomorrow is cast into the oven, how much more you, O ye of little faith! Be not solicitous therefore saying: What shall we eat, or what shall we drink, or wherewith shall we be clothed? for after all these things do the heathens seek. For your Father knoweth that you have need of all these things. Seek ye therefore first the Kingdom of God, and His justice; and all these things shall be added unto you.


