Pastor's Note

SAINT MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE AND THE SACRED HEART

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690), a French nun of the

Visitation Order, is the privileged soul through whom Our Lord revealed the secrets of His Sacred Heart which have become such an important part of our Catholic faith-life. In 1671, she entered the convent at Paray-le-Monial.

On December 27th, 1673, the Feast of Saint John the Evangelist and the Third Day of Christmas, Sister Margaret-Mary experienced the first of her great revelations. She was kneeling alone at the grille which separated the nuns from the sanctuary. The Blessed Sacrament was exposed on the altar in the monstrance for adoration.

All at once she felt herself, as she says, 'invested', by the divine Presence, and heard Our Lord inviting her to take the place which St. John has occupied at the Last Supper. He then went on speaking 'in so plain and effective a manner as to leave no room for doubt...' He told her that the love of His Heart must needs spread and manifest itself to men, by means of her, and that He would reveal the treasures of His graces through her, His chosen instrument and the disciple of His Sacred Heart. Then it was as though Our Lord took her heart and put it within His own, returning it burning with divine love into her breast. (Butler's Lives of the Saints, Thurston edition)

The culminating great revelation to her occurred during the Octave of the Feast of Corpus Christ, 1675 when Our Lord said to Sister Margaret-Mary:

Behold the Heart which has so much loved men that it has spared nothing, even exhausting and consuming Itself in testimony of Its love. Instead of gratitude, I receive from most only indifference, by irreverence and sacrilege and the coldness and scorn that men have for me in the Sacrament of Love.

Then Christ asked that a feast of Reparation be instituted for the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. [This is now the annual feast-day of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.]

Thus through His chosen instrument God made known to the world His will concerning the reparation due for human ingratitude towards His goodness and mercy, by worship of the Heart of flesh of His Son, considered as united to His divinity and as the symbol of His love in dying for our Redemption.

Our Mass of the Sacred Heart this Sunday as an External Solemnity amplifies for us the importance of these revelations, the juxtaposition of the great love of God for man and the cold, indifference of the greater part of mankind to it. Indeed we are bound to dedicate ourselves to co-operation with this prayer of reparation to the Sacred Heart, and to be filled with gratitude for all of the goodness we receive from that same Wounded Heart.



LATIN MASS PROPERS: MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

INTROIT: *Psalm 32. 11, 19* The thoughts of His Heart are from generation to generation: To deliver their souls from death and feed them in famine. Ps. Rejoice in the Lord, O ye just, praise becometh the upright. V. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT: O God, Who in the Heart of Thy Son, wounded by our sins, dost mercifully vouchsafe to bestow upon us the infinite wealth of Thy love; grant, we beseech Thee, that revering It with meet devotion, we may fulfil our duty of worthy reparation. Through the same our Lord.

EPISTLE: *Ephesians 3.8-19* Brethren: To me, the least of all the Saints, is given the grace, to preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ: and to enlighten all men, that they may see what is the dispensation of the mystery which hath been hidden from eternity in God, Who created all things: that the manifold wisdom of God may be made known to the principalities and powers in heavenly places through the Church, according to the eternal purpose which He made in Christ Jesus our Lord: in Whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of Him. For this cause I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of Whom all paternity in Heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened by His Spirit with might unto the inward man, that Christ may dwell by faith in your hearts: that being rooted and grounded in charity, you may be able to comprehend with all the Saints, what is the breadth and length, and height and depth: to know also the charity of Christ which surpasseth all knowledge. That you may be filled unto all the fullness of God.

GRADUAL: *Psalm 24. 8, 9* The Lord is sweet and righteous: therefore He will give a law to sinners in the way. V. He will guide the mild in judgment: He will teach the meek His ways. ALLELUIA: *Matthew 11. 29* Alleluia, alleluia. V. Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me, because I am meek and humble of heart: and you shall find rest to your souls. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: John 19. 31-37 **A**t that time: The Jews (because it was the Passover), that the bodies might not remain on the cross on the Sabbath day (for that was a great Sabbath day), besought Pilate that their legs might be broken: and that they might be taken away. The soldiers therefore came: and they broke the legs of the first, and of the other that was crucified with him. But after they were come to Jesus, when they saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs. But one of the soldiers, with a spear opened His side, and immediately there came out blood and water. And he knoweth that saw it, hath given testimony: and his testimony is true. And he knoweth that he saith true, that you may believe. For these things were done that the Scripture might be fulfilled: You shall not break a bone of Him. And again another Scripture saith: They shall look on Him Whom they pierced.

OFFERTORY: *Psalm 68. 21* My Heart hath expected reproach and misery: and I looked for one that would grieve together with Me, but there was none: and for one that would comfort Me, and I found none.

SECRET: Look, we beseech Thee, O Lord, upon the ineffable love of the Heart of Thy beloved Son; that our offering may be acceptable unto Thee and atone for all our sins. Through the same our Lord.


