

Our Sunday Mass today is the Feast of the Transfiguration of

Our Lord, the pre-view of the resurrected glory of Christ which the three chief Apostles—Peter, James, and John—saw on Mount Tabor before the Crucifixion had taken place. Although the vision did not prevent the Apostles from being overthrown during the event of Christ's Passion, it was a further support to their faith once they had experienced the Risen Christ in their midst. Each Mass is also an experience of the Miracle of the Transfiguration of Our Lord through the Mystery of Faith which is the Holy Eucharist. "Behold! The Lamb of God...."






PHOTO: (left) The Massabielle outside of Lourdes, as it looked in 1858, the Year of the Apparitions.


PARISH DRIVE to HELP the NEWTON FOOD PANTRY: JULY 23rd - August 6th 2023

LATIN MASS PROPERS: GOSPEL LESSON for the TENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST: St. Luke, 18. 9-14.

AT THAT TIME, Jesus spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves as just, and despised others. Two men went up into the Temple to pray; the one was a pharisee, and the other a publican. The pharisee standing, prayed thus with himself: O God, I give Thee thanks that I am not as the rest of men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers; as also is this publican. I fast twice in the week; I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican standing afar off would not so much as lift up his eyes towards heaven, but struck his breast saying: O God, be merciful to me a sinner. I say to you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: because every one that exalteth himself shall be humbled, and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

EPISTLE From the Second Letter of Blessed Peter the Apostle, I. 16-19.DEARLY beloved: We have not followed artificial fables, when we made known to you the power and presence of our Lord Jesus Christ; but having been made eyewitnesses of His greatness. For He received from God the Father honor and glory; this voice coming down to Him from the excellent glory, This is My beloved Son in whom I am well pleased, hear ye Him. And this voice we heard brought from heaven, when we were with Him in the holy mount. And we have the more firm prophetical word, whereunto you do well to attend, as to a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day-star arise in your hearts.

And His face did shine as the sun: and His garments became white as snow. And behold there appeared to them Moses and Elias talking with Him. And Peter answering said to Jesus: Lord, it is good for us to be here: if Thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles, one for Thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias. And as he was yet speaking, behold a bright cloud overshadowed them. And lo, a voice out of the cloud, saying: This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased: hear ye Him. And the disciples hearing, fell upon their face and were very much afraid. And Jesus came and touched them, and said to them: Arise, and fear not. And they lifting up their eyes saw no one, but only Jesus. And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying: Tell the vision to no man until the Son of Man be risen from the dead.




