## **Pastor's Note**



Fr. Híggíns THE APPARITIONS OF MARY IMMACULATE AT LOURDES ACCORDING TO THE **LITURGICAL CALENDAR** 

The Apparitions of Our Lady at Lourdes to Bernadette Soubirous in 1858 can be best understood by correlating them to the liturgical calendar then in use. There we can see how well they align with the Patristic Church's Easter Baptismal Catechesis. Here follows an outline:

1st Apparition: Thursday in Shrovetide (February 11th, 1858), the Night Office for this day presents the Covenant of God with Noah after the Great Flood and the Rainbow in the heavens as the sign of God's reconciliation. The waters of the Great Flood prefigure the waters of Christ's Baptism and Noah's Ark the Ark of Christ's Catholic Church—the Ark of Salvation.

2nd Apparition: Shrove Sunday (February 14th)

3rd Apparition: Thursday after Ash Wednesday (February 18th): The Vision addresses Bernadette for the first time and asks the girl to visit her there for a fortnight.

### The Fortnight: Weeks I & II of Lent

4th Apparition: Friday after Ash. Also, the Feast of the Sacred Crown of Thorns, the Third in the series of seven particular Feasts of the Passion which were said on designated days in Septuagesima and Lent. In 1858, these were observed in the diocese to which Lourdes belonged. (February 19th)

5th Apparition: Saturday after Ash (February 20th) Lenten Gospel Lesson: Jesus walks on the water and calms the storm. Mark 6:47-56

6th Apparition: First Sunday in Lent. The Gospel Lesson is of the Temptation of Christ in the Desert. Matt. 4:1-11 (February 21st)

**LENTEN REGULATIONS** 

**CURRENT DISCIPLINE** Davs of Abstinence Begins on one's 14th birthday. Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. **Obliges abstention from** flesh meat.

**Days of Penance** Applies to all the Faithful. Lent and Fridays outside of Lent.

**Days of Fast Everyone aged 18-59.** 1 full meal permitted, two other meals may be taken which, when combined, are less than a full meal. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.


(The obligation to do penance is lifted on Fridays which are also celebrated as a solemnity: e.g., Christmas Day).

**OLDER DISCIPLINE Days of Abstinence** Applies on one's 7th birthday. **Complete Abstinence on** all Fridays of the year, Ash Wednesday, and the Vigil of Christmas. **Partial Abstinence (meat** and soup, or gravy made from meat permitted once a day at principal meal) weekdays of Lent, Ember Days of Wednesday & Saturday, Vigils of Pentecost & Assumption. (Abstinence dispensed on Holy Days of Obligation.)

**Days of Fast** Everyone aged 21-59. Days of Lent from Ash Wednesday on, Ember Davs, Vigils of Christmas, Pentecost and the Assumption. One full meal permitted, with 2 smaller meals.

### The Fortnight: Weeks I & II of Lent

Monday of the First Week in Lent, the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter at Antioch (February 22nd): No Apparition to Bernadette.

7th Apparition: Tuesday of the First Week in Lent (February 23rd). Lenten Gospel Lesson: Jesus cleanses the Temple on Palm Sunday, Matthew 21:10-17.

8th Apparition: Ember Wednesday in Lent (February 24th). During her ecstasy Bernadette is heard to say: "Penance ... Penance ... Penance." Lenten Gospel Lesson: Jesus tells the Pharisees the only sign that will be shown them is the "Sign of Jonas" (i.e., His own death and Resurrection from the Tomb). Matthew 12:38-50.

9th Apparition: Thursday of the First Week in Lent (February 25th) The Apparition commands Bernadette to "Go and drink at the spring and wash yourself in it." Bernadette digs in the dirt where the Vision indicates. Only on her 4th attempt is she able to drink a little muddy water. Lenten Gospel Lesson: The Canaanite mother who begs Christ to deliver her possessed daughter. Matthew 15:21-28.

Ember Friday in Lent (February 26th) and the Feast of the Holy Lance and Nails. The Beautiful Lady does not appear to Bernadette, but the people of Lourdes are amazed to find water gushing from the side of the great rock, from the very place were Bernadette had been digging in the dirt the day before. This is the first Sign given to the people: the water gushing from the side of the rock is a symbol of the water and blood flowing from the side of Christ on the Cross, John 19:35.



## HISTORICAL NOTE

At the time of the Lourdes' Apparitions, 1858, Shrove Sunday (the Sunday before Ash Wednesday) was also commonly known as "FORTY HOURS SUNDAY" on account of the practice of holding solemn exposition of the Blessed Sacrament over three days, from Shrove Sunday to Shrove Tuesday, in honor of the 40 hours Jesus passed in the Tomb and as an atonement for the excesses of "Carnival". Bernadette was praying in church on Shrove Sunday (February 14th) when she felt an interior calling to return to the Grotto where she had seen the beautiful young lady three days earlier (February 11th).

## LATIN MASS PROPERS: GOSPEL LESSON FOR QUINQUAGESIMA SUNDAY

Luke 18. 31-43 At that time Jesus took unto Him the Twelve and said to them: Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things shall be accomplished which were written by the Prophets concerning the Son of Man. For He shall be delivered to the Gentiles, and shall be mocked and scourged and spit upon: and after they have scourged Him, they will put Him to death, and the third day He shall rise again. And they understood none of these things, and this word was hid from them, and they understood not the things that were said. Now it came to pass, when He drew nigh to Jericho, that a certain blind man sat by the wayside, begging. And when he heard the multitude passing by, he asked what this meant. And they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by. And he cried out, saying: Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me. And Jesus standing, commanded him to be brought unto Him. And when he was come near, He asked him, saying: What wilt thou that I do to thee? But he said: Lord, that I may see. And Jesus said unto him: Receive thy sight, thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he saw and followed Him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.

Gospel Lesson: Mary, Full of Grace Luke 1:26-31 ("And [the Angel Gabriel] came to her and said, 'Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee...'

**INTROIT:** Apocalypse 21. 2, Psalm 44. 2 I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. *Psalm*. My heart hath uttered a good word; I speak my works to the King.  $\tilde{V}$ . Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — I saw...

**COLLECT:** O God, who by the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin didst prepare a worthy habitation for Thy Son; we humbly beseech Thee, that we who celebrate the feast of the Apparition of the same holy Virgin, may obtain health of both soul and body. Through our Lord ...

EPISTLE: From the Apocalypse of St. John 11. 19., 12. 1, 10 And the temple of God was opened in heaven; and the ark of His testament was seen in His temple, and there were lightnings and voice, and an earthquake and great hail. And a great sign appeared in heaven: A woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. And I heard a loud voice in heaven saying: Now is come salvation and strength and the Kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ.

GRADUAL: Canticle of Canticles 2. 12, 10, 14 The flowers have appeared in our land, the time of pruning is come, the voice of the turtle-dove is heard in our land. V. Arise, my love, my beautiful one, and come; my dove in the clefts of the rock, in the hollow places of the wall. TRACT Judith 15, 10 Thou art the glory of Jerusalem, thou art the joy of Israel, thou art the honor of our people. V. Thou art all beautiful, O Mary, and there is no stain of original sin in thee. V. Truly happy art thou, O holy Virgin Mary, and most worthy of all high praise; for with thy virgin foot thou hast crushed the serpent's head.

GOSPEL: Continuation of the holy Gospel according to St. Luke 1. 26-31 **A**t that time, the angel Gabriel was sent from God into a city of Galilee, called Nazareth, to a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David: and the Virgin's name was Mary. And the angel being come in, said unto her: Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. Who having heard, was troubled at his saying and thought with herself what manner of salutation this should be. And the angel said to her: Fear not, Mary, for thou hast found grace with God. Behold thou shalt conceive in thy womb and shalt bring forth a Son: and thou shalt call His name Jesus.

OFFERTORY: Luke 1. 28 Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee, blessed art thou amongst women.

**SECRET:** May the sacrifice of praise, which we offer Thee, O Lord, by the merits of the glorious and Immaculate Virgin, rise up to heaven as a sweet savour: and may it obtain for us that physical and moral health which we desire. Through our Lord.

**COMMUNION:** Psalm 44. 10 Thou hast visited the earth, and hast plentifully watered it; thou hast in many ways enriched it.

**POSTCOMMUNION:** May the right hand of Thine Immaculate Mother raise up those, O Lord, whom Thou hast fed plenteously with food from heaven, that through her help we may come to our everlasting home. Who livest and reignest ...
