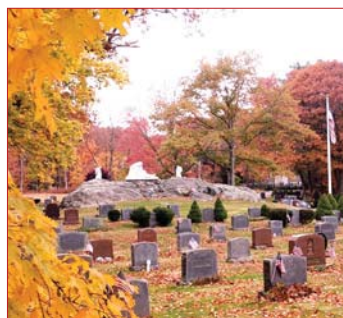

Pastor's Note

Joined together at the beginning of November on two successive days is the Feast of All Saints (All Saints' Day) with the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day). The first celebrates the heavenly bliss of all of the Saints in Heaven: the second makes prayer of intercession for those saved souls who are passing through their Purgatory before they can enter Heaven.

Make no mistake, however: the Souls in Purgatory are *saved* souls: they are among the "elect", they have died in the state of grace, their crown of glory is secure. It is the duty of the Church on earth to help speed along these Holy Souls by our own prayers and penances for the dead. We should be remembering our own beloved dead and all of the faithful departed throughout the year, but especially during the days of November, that month of the year especially dedicated to the Holy Souls. Let no-one scruple that prayers for dead relatives and friends are a disrespect to their memory. If they are already in Heaven and no longer need our prayers, those surplus prayers are an almsdeed for other forgotten souls who have no-one left on earth to pray for them.

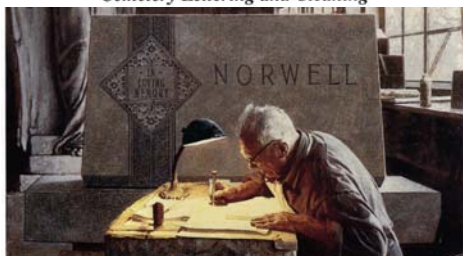
