One of the last acts of the Francis Papacy was the canonization of the Sixteen Blessed Carmelite Martyrs of Compiègne, who were guillotined during the French Revolution. This canonization, announced on December 18th, 2024, was an “equipollent” canonization, that is, an equivalent canonization outside of the normal procedures.

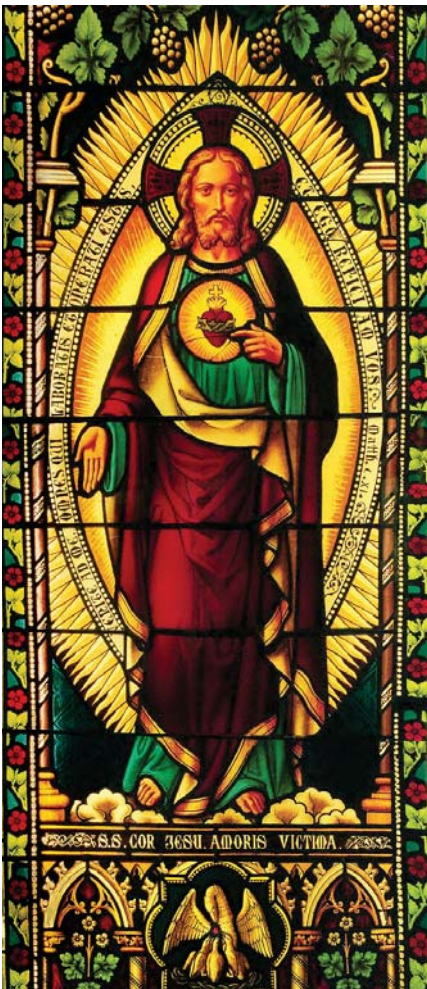

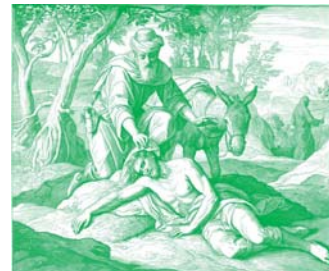

## LATIN MASS PROPERS: FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

**INTROIT:** *Psalm 26: 7, 9* Hear, O Lord, my voice with which I have cried to Thee: be Thou my helper, forsake me not, nor do Thou despise me, O God my Saviour. *Psalm 26: 1* The Lord is my light, and my salvation, whom shall I fear. V. Glory be to the Father.

**COLLECT** O God, who hast prepared for those who love Thee such good things as eye hath not seen; pour into our hearts such love towards Thee, that we loving Thee above all things, may obtain Thy promises, which exceed all that we can desire. Through our Lord.

**EPISTLE:** *I Peter 3: 8-15* Dearly beloved: Be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, being lovers of the brotherhood, merciful, modest, humble; not rendering evil for evil, nor railing for railing, but contrariwise, blessing: for unto this are you called, that you may inherit a blessing. For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile. Let him decline from evil and do good; let him seek after peace, and pursue it; because the eyes of the Lord are upon the just, and His ears unto their prayers, but the countenance of the Lord is against them that do evil things. And who is he that can hurt you, if you be zealous of good? But if also you suffer anything for justice' sake, blessed are ye. And be not afraid of their fear, and be not troubled; but sanctify the Lord Christ in your hearts.

**GRADUAL:** *Psalm 83: 9, 10* Behold, O God our protector and look on Thy servants. V. O Lord God of hosts, give ear to the prayers of Thy servants. Alleluia, alleluia. *Psalm 20: 1* V. In Thy strength, O Lord, the king shall joy; and in Thy salvation he shall rejoice exceedingly. Alleluia.

**GOSPEL:** *Matthew 5: 20-24* At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: Except your justice abound more than that of the Scribes and Pharisees, you shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. You have heard that it was said to them of old: Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill, shall be in danger of the judgment. But I say to you that whosoever is angry with his brother, shall be in danger of the judgment; and whosoever shall say to his brother: *Raca*, shall be in danger of the council; and whosoever shall say: Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire. If therefore thou offer thy gift at the altar, and there thou remember that thy brother hath anything against thee, leave there thy offering before the altar, and go first to be reconciled to thy brother; and then coming thou shalt offer thy gift.

**OFFERTORY:** *Psalm 15: 7, 8* I will bless the Lord, who hath given me understanding; I set God always in my sight; for He is at my right hand, that I be not moved.

**SECRET** Be appeased, we beseech Thee, O Lord, by our supplications: and in Thy loving kindness, accept the offerings Thy servants and handmaidens lay before Thee, that the offerings of each to the glory of Thy name may profit all alike unto salvation. Through our Lord.

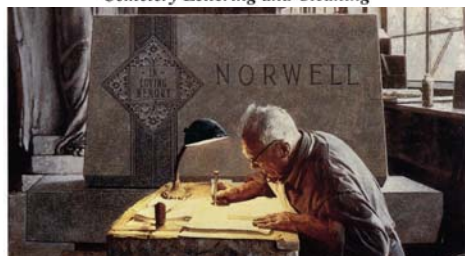

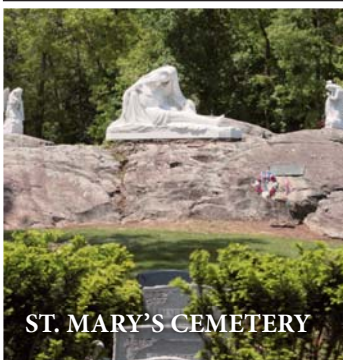
