The Arrest of Robespierre and the End of the Reign of Terror: July 27th, 1794 A.D.

Ten days after the deaths of the Sixteen Carmelite



Martyrs by the guillotine (July 17th, 1794), the men who were directing this "Reign of Terror" in the French Revolution were themselves deposed and quickly dispatched to the guillotine. The illustration above shows the leader Maximilian Robespierre just after he has been seized. The abrupt overthrow of the persecutors and the terror masters is attributed to the intercession of these Carmelite Martyrs.
